The Experimental Aircraft Association started in 1953. It is a growing organization now based in Oshkosh, Wisconsin. Initially, EAA members were interested in building their own aircraft. Currently, the interests of those involved in EAA have expanded to include almost any vehicle of flight. Whatever your interests, however, the EAA gives everyone an opportunity to learn, share stories and develop long-lasting friendships. There is literally something for everyone.

### Chapter 572 Meetings

Our EAA Chapter 572 is comprised of members who are pilots or aviation enthusiasts. The members come from a wide variety of backgrounds with a common interest in aviation. EAA Chapter 572 has meetings at the Fond du Lac Airport, in our clubhouse. The meetings are held the first Saturday of every month at 8:00AM. Board of Director meetings are held on the same day, at 7:00AM. All club members are welcome to attend the Board meetings. We hold our meetings at our club house located by the rotating beacon at the airport. Winter meetings are held at a local restaurant. Call or see website for details.

During the meetings, we discuss various aviation events taking place throughout Wisconsin and make transportation arrangements to attend as many as possible. Events include "fly-outs" to various points of interest to the group, pancake breakfasts, air shows, and safety seminars. Unofficial fly-outs for breakfast occur almost every Sunday at 7:30. Space is limited. Come early.

## Local Activities for Chapter 572

EAA Chapter 572 also hosts a number of local events including the Young Eagle flights on the 1st Sat each month, April thru Oct, which are geared toward introducing aviation to children.

EAA Chapter 572 members, friends and other volunteers park nearly 2000 airplanes at the Fond du Lac Airport during the annual EAA Convention in Oshkosh.

During the EAA AirVenture Convention, the Wisconsin Aviation Museum, Inc., located in Fond du Lac, is open for self-guided tours. The admission is free to the public and participation in museum activities is encouraged. EAA Chapter 572 is a major sponsor of the museum and its activities.

Chapter members also have a "tie-down" party. The members set up an assembly line system to produce airplane tie-downs which are sold to pilots during the convention. This activity is usually held on an evening prior to the convention and includes pizza and drinks.

EAA Chapter 572 built a shower facility that is used by camping pilots who land in Fond du Lac during the AirVenture Convention. The shower building was built by the local EAA chapter members and was available for use during EAA AirVenture 2000.
